HOMESTAY AT HUARAZ

06 Days / 05 Nights

CONTENT: HUARAZ / HUARAZ: Excursion to Chavín de Huantar / HUARAZ: Huascarán National Park - Llanganuco Lakes - Humacchuco / HUARAZ: María Josefa trail excursion / HUARAZ: Excursion to Pastoruri Glacier / HUARAZ



DAY 01

HUARAZ

Regular bus to Huaraz. Representative to meet you at the bus station and transfer to selected hotel. Overnight at hotel.

DAY 02

HUARAZ: Excursion to Chavín de Huantar

Breakfast. Today we will visit the remains of the Peruvian civilization and main center of its religious worship. It is located in a mountainous region, but is accessible by crossing the Andes mountains. We will make a stop at the Quericocha Lagoon. Return to Huaraz late in the afternoon. Overnight at hotel.

DAY 03

HUARAZ: Huascarán National Park - Llanganuco Lakes -Humacchuco

Breakfast. Departure from the hotel for an excursion to the Huascarán National Park. We climb up to the Llanganuco lakes and then continue to the viewpoint at Portachuelo, a special place in the mountain range where we can see Andean flora and fauna of the high Andes, and the beautiful snowy peaks of the highest mountains in the range: Huascarán (the highest at 6,768 m) and Huandoy (6,395 m). On our way back we go to the Llanganuco gorge and take a walk along the "María Josefa" trail. After the walk, we continue to the community of Humacchuco, near the Huascarán National Park in the Cordillera Blanca. **Dinner** and overnight at a local family house.

Note: *Due to heavy rainfalls that can make the path difficult to follow, the María Josefa trail is from May to September. For the rest of the season we walk along the Chinancocha trail. Weather permitting, we include a short walk to the outskirts of the community. Lunch today is not included and we recommend you bring a snack or packed lunch.*

DAY 04

HUARAZ: Huascanan national park - walk along María Josefa trail

Breakfast. Opportunity to enjoy an Andean sunrise. This morning we go for a one-hour walk to the Keushu Lagoon. Lunch at the community. Collection from the community in the afternoon (3.30 p.m. - 4 p.m.) in shared transport, to continue with visits to the valley known as Callejón de Huaylas, arriving at Caraz at approximately 7 p.m. Return to Huaraz. Overnight at hotel.

**DAY 05****HUARAZ: Excursion to the Pastoruri Glacier**

Breakfast. Departure from the city of Huaraz southbound to a sector called Pachacoto, where you can visit the Puya Raimondi, a bromeliad that can reach up to 12m in height. With thousands of flowers and millions of seeds, it is the queen of the high Andean mountains flora. We will see cave painting on the rock walls and carbonated mineral water springs and then go for a one-hour walk towards the base of the glacier. Return to Huaraz. Overnight at hotel.

DAY 06**HUARAZ**

Breakfast. Leisure time in the morning to visit the market or regional museum, or to walk around the city. Mid-morning transfer to the bus station or airport.
