### DAY 01

AYACUCHO: City Tour

Departure from Arequipa station to Puno. Cocktail. Dinner on board. Night on board

### DAY 02

AYACUCHO: Archaeological Remains of Wari + Quinua Town + Pampa de la Quinua

Breakfast. Excursion to the Wari Archaeological Complex, former capital of the Empire of the same name, with superimposed three-story stone structures, an aqueduct, underground passages, amphitheater, vaults and lintels composed of large blocks of flat stones. Visit to the village of Quinua, inhabited basically by potters who offer their products to the visitors. Visit to the Pampa de Quinua, place where the battle of Ayacucho was fought. Return to the city of Ayacucho and Accommodation.

### DAY 03

AYACUCHO: Transfer to bus station or Airport

Breakfast. At the agreed time, transfer to the airport or bus station.
