DAY 01 LIMA

Arrival at Jorge Chávez International Airport where you will be met by our representative. Transfer to selected hotel. Overnight at hotel.

DAY 02

LIMA: City Tour – Colonial and Modern + Archaeological Museum

Breakfast. Visit to city's historic center: guided tour of the Cathedral, and a panoramic tour of the Convents of Santo Domingo and of San Francisco; the Main Square and San Martin Square. The visit continues to the residential neighborhoods of San Isidro and Miraflores, followed by a visit to the Archaeological Museum which houses archaeological pieces representing the different Peruvian cultures that preceded the Incas together with its collection of metal works and textiles. Rest of the afternoon free. You can taste the famous Peruvian cuisine, visit the Bohemian district of Barranco, cradle of poets and writers, and part of the literary tour of Mario Vargas Llosa, or visit some of the capital's many other attractions. Overnight at selected hotel.

DAY 03

LIMA / CUZCO: City walking tour

Breakfast. Transfer to the airport for the flight to Cuzco, capital of the ancient empire. In the afternoon, walking tour of the city for an exclusive circuit that includes the main Square in the district of San Blas, Hatunrumiyoc Street with the "12-angle stone", Nazarenas square, main square, Inca Museum, Cuzco Central Market, Loreto Street, the Cathedral and the Koricancha or Temple of the Sun. Overnight at hotel.

DAY 04

CUZCO / SACRED VALLEY: Chinchero-Maras-Moray and Ollantaytambo / MACHU PICCHU (Aguas Calientes)

Breakfast. Visiting the Andean village of Chinchero, the archaeological area, its colonial church, the main square where you can visit an authentic open-air artisan market (if it is a Sunday, enjoy its traditional market selling locally-made handicrafts and goods). We will also visit a textile workshop where the weavers will demonstrate their techniques using natural dyes.

Continue to the Maras' salt mines, a salt supply station during the Inca period and still in use today, before visiting Moray's agricultural laboratory, characterized by its steep terraces with their diverse micro climates. **Lunch**.

In the afternoon, visit the Ollantaytambo fortress and then transfer to the train station for the train to Aguas Calientes town. Arrival and transfer to selected hotel. Rest of the afternoon free. **Dinner** and overnight at the selected hotel.

Luggage for Machu Picchu: Due to luggage restrictions imposed by the train companies (to allow visibility through the panoramic windows), only hand luggage is allowed. One small travel bag, rucksack or carry-on bag per person is permitted, weighing no more than 5 kg (in addition to handbags). The remaining luggage will be taken to the hotel in Cuzco where you return to for your overnight stay.

DAY 05

Visit to MACHU PICCHU / CUSCO

Breakfast. Early morning departure to Machu Picchu, one of the wonders of the modern world, to visit the Inca citadel before it gets busy and enjoy one of the most impressive natural spaces on the planet. Guided tour around the archaeological complex located in a unique natural setting, (the terraces, squares, temples palaces, stairways, warehouses, water fountains, including the Temple of the Sun, etc.).

Free time to enjoy the site, with the possibility to climb Huayna Picchu or Machu Picchu (book in advance). Return to Aguas Calientes by bus to walk around the market and enjoy this lively town where almost every traveler who comes to the country passes through. At the scheduled time, departure from the train station returning to Ollantaytambo or Poroy, and transfer to the hotel in Cuzco. Overnight at hotel.

Note: If you want to climb Huayna Picchu or Machu Picchu (not to be confused with the archaeological site), please ask for this to be booked when confirming your reservation. Supplement payable in advance.

Lunch is not included today so as to allow as much time as possible at the archaeological site. For morning visits, there will be time to make your own lunch arrangements after the visit, or before visiting the site if an afternoon visit is scheduled.

DAY 06

CUSCO / LIMA / CITY OF ORIGIN

Breakfast. Transfer to the airport to take the flight back to Lima. Arrival, airport assistance for connecting return flight to city of origin. End of our services.

RECOMMENDATIONS

- -Flights must be booked in advance: -02 flights: Lima / Cuzco / Lima.
- -This program can be shortened by changing the excursion to Sacred Valley for the visit to Machu Picchu on the same day.

NOTE: All hotel categories include travel in Expedition class (Perú Rail) or Voyager class (Inca Rail), subject to availability. The Vistadome train is available on request - supplement applies.

- All transfers airport / hotel / station and vice versa in shared service.
- Train category Voyager (Inca Rail), according to availability, between Ollantaytambo / Machu Picchu / Ollantaytambo, in shared service. Section of an hour and a half of duration (this route does not have accompanying guide, since he waits for them in the town of Machu Picchu Aguas Calientes). Request Vistadome train supplement from Peru Rail (round trip), or Machu Picchu train from Inca Rail for just the return.
- International flights.
- Domestic flights (Check the price reference table, below).
- Rates of airports, ports, aerodromes, etc.
- Feeding not mentioned.
- Entry and reservation to Mount Huayna Picchu or Mount Machu Picchu (optional with limited places and must be confirmed when confirming the program).
- Excursions not mentioned or detailed as optional, tickets to museums, monuments and others not mentioned in the program.



- Stay of 5 nights on a accommodation and breakfast basis according to the chosen category.
- 01 Lunch and 01 Dinner at the specified places (drinks not included).
